

SAMPLE BIBLIOGRAPHY

- Alphabetize by the first word listed in each entry.
 - Alphabetize by the author's (or editor's) last name.
 - Entries without an author are alphabetized by title.
- Entire bibliography must be double spaced (double space between and within entries).
- Begin each entry flush with the left margin.
- Indent subsequent lines (use hanging indent).
- Don't number, bullet point, or label the entries.
- Single volume encyclopedias should use the book format.
